Heart Ornaments

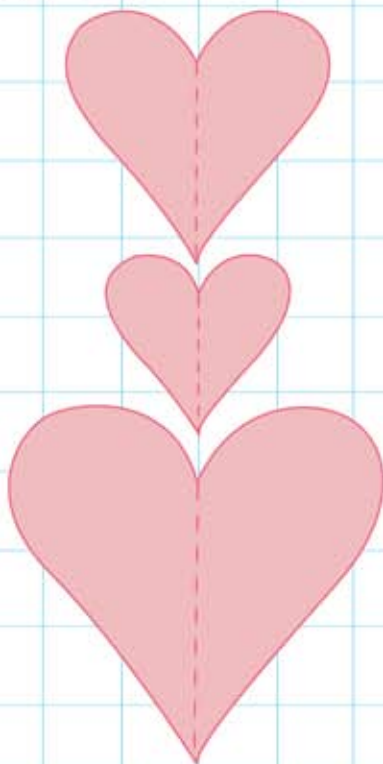
- 1 Cut four equally-sized hearts from patterned paper; score and fold along center.
- 2 Adhere together.
- 3 Punch hole in top.
- 4 String buttons and beads on thread; knot and loop through hole.
- 5 Decorate as desired.

Bonus Idea

Hang the hearts separately for a mobile effect.

HEART PATTERNS Enlarge 250%

Cut 4 of each size from patterned paper



Each square = 1". Cut on solid lines.
Score on dashed lines.



SUPPLIES: *Patterned paper:* (Crush, Tender, Embrace, Affection, Adore from Beloved collection) *Tinkering Ink Accents:* (alphabet die cuts) *Tinkering Ink:* (assorted buttons) *Autumn Leaves:* (felt flowers) *American Crafts:* (assorted beads) *Rub-ons:* (All Mixed Up alphabet) *Doodlebug Design Stickers:* (hearts) *Doodlebug Design Fibers:* (red floss) *DMC Die:* (scalloped square) *Provo Craft Tools:* (die cut machine) *Provo Craft:* (3/8" circle punch)
